

Dual Eligibles & The Facts on Balance Billing

Protecting Dual Eligible Beneficiaries from Improper Charges







What is Balance Billing?

- o Balance billing (also known as improper billing) happens when Medicare providers charge dual eligible beneficiaries ('Medi-Medi') for services covered by Medicare and Medi-Cal. This is **illegal** under federal and California law.
- If you have both Medicare and Medi-Cal, you should NOT be billed for:
 - Co-pays
 - Co-insurance
 - Deductibles
- o This protection also applies to Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries (QMBs Full Medi-Cal).

• Key Facts for Dual Eligibles & QMBs

- o You should never receive a bill for Medicare cost-sharing.
- \circ Do not pay for covered physician visits or medical services.
- Medicare Advantage or Medi-Medi Plan members should not pay when using innetwork providers.

• Exceptions - When You May Receive a Bill

- Prescription drug (Part D) co-pays
- Monthly Medi-Cal share of cost
- Services not covered by Medicare or Medi-Cal

How Should Providers Bill?

- o Medicare pays 80% of the allowed rate. Medi-Cal covers the rest via a 'crossover claim.'
- o For Original Medicare: Provider bills Medicare -> Medicare sends claim to Medi-Cal.
- For MA Plans: Provider bills MA Plan for primary Medicare payment -> Provider sends claim to Medi-Cal for secondary Medi-Cal payment.
- o **Note:** Providers don't need to be in the Medi-Cal network but must be enrolled as an active or 'Crossover Only' Medi-Cal provider.

What If You Receive a Bill?

- Don't pay it! Contact the provider and explain your dual eligibility.
- The provider must:
 - Refund any payments
 - Stop collections
 - Fix any credit issues

• Types of Dual Eligible Beneficiaries

- Full Duals
 - Eligible for full Medicare & Medi-Cal
 - May qualify for Dual Special Needs Plans (D-SNPs)
 - Medi-Cal helps with co-pays, premiums, and long-term care
- Partial Duals
 - Receive help through Medicare Savings Programs (MSPs)
 - Do NOT receive full Medi-Cal medical benefits
